constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted.


1. Mayor announced purpose of the meeting was to hear Mr. Coppage, representative from the State Health Department, Austin, Texas, in a discussion of the proposed campaign to rid the City of rats in the interest of health conditions, especially, to combat Typhus Fever. Mr. Coppage explained the plan and estimated a revolving fund of \$2,500.00 would be necessary.
2. He also had copies of an Ordinance that is used by the City of Laredo, Texas in this work and recommended that Lufkin pass one similar if we go into this proposed campaign.
3. No official action was taken, but the belief was expressed that the property owners in the business district of the City would favor, and approve this movement in which event he was assured the City would take the necessary steps to carry out the plan.
4. The City Manager presented a revised map of the City, containing all official subdivisions up to date. On motion of Arthur Temple, Jr., second by B. F. Milligan, the map was approved and accepted.

No further business was presented and the meeting was adjourned.
