

MINUTES OF Regular MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD February 8th  
1950 at 7:30 P. M.

On this the 8th day of February, A. D., 1951, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in Regular Session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to wit:

being present, and the following absent: L.B. Zeagler

constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Citizen Joe Wilson appeared before the Commission to complain of damage done to his property by the overflow of water from the street and to report as a nuisance water standing in the ditch adjoining his property.

2. The January bills were approved as reported, on motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner Stegall.

3. Mr. Steenson reported on a request made by the Kurth Library that the City assume responsibility for the maintenance of the library grounds. The Council recommended that the City continue its present policy of cooperative work with the library.

4. Mr. Steenson read a report from the State which indicated that the traffic flow at the junction of Abney Street with North Raguet was of such proportions as to justify the installation of a traffic light. It was the Council's recommendation that the purchase of this light be proposed in the 1951-1952 budget.

5. Mr. Steenson recommended that the following summer swimming rates be adopted:

<u>Years of Age</u>	<u>Rate</u>
Under 12	\$ 0.09
12 But Under 18	0.25
18 and All ages over	0.40

6. Free swimming two mornings each week to all ages under 12. The Council voted approval of this recommendation on motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner Stegall.

7. An ordinance prescribing the procedure for candidates to file for the offices of Mayor, or other offices for the City of Lufkin, was passed on motion of Commissioner Treadwell, seconded by Commissioner Snell.


8. The Zone change as requested by Ethel Hill was finally passed on motion of Commissioner Treadwell, seconded by Commissioner Snell.

9. The minutes of the two council meetings held on January 4th and January 16th were approved as read, on motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner Treadwell.

10. Consideration was given to the State's request that the City of Lufkin procure additional Right-of-way on the proposed extension of Frank Street to Highway No. 94, for the purpose of providing for the necessary drainage. It was the council's recommendation that additional consideration be given the request.

11. Dr. Joe Burch appeared before the Council to reiterate his request that a sewer extension be made to his property at Two Point at such time as the City is financially able to do so.

The meeting adjourned on motion Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner Stegall.
