MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, HELD JULY 25, 1929.

Be it remembred that on this the 25th day of July A.D. 1929, there was begun and holden a call meeing of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding:- Joe C. Denman, Mayor, C. E. Brazil, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, C. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, W. O. Seale, City Attorney, J. B. Woiton, City Engineer and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The question of the point of destination of the proposed street paving on S. Bynum street came up for discussion and consideration, after which it was moved by W.A.Abney and seconded by R.C.Jordan that the point be fixed as the S.E.corner of N.D.Wright's property fronting on said street. The motion carried unanimously.

A resolution designating certain streets, alleys, avenues to be paved was presented for passage on second reading. On motion made by C.A.Burke and seconded by C.E.Brazil said ordinance or resolution was passed on second reading. See another page for a record of the resolution and the streets to be paved.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE APPROVING CONTRACT WITH MCCLENDON & GREEN, CONTRACTORS OF HOUSTON, TEXAS, FOR SEWERAGE DISPOSAL PLANT IMPROVEMENTS, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF SAID CONTRACT ON THE BEHALF OF THE CITY, APPROVING BOND IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, was presented for passage and approval on second and final reading. It was moved by R.C.Jordan and seconded by C.A.Burke that said ordinance be finally passed and approved on second reading. Each membered voted "Aye". Therefore same was unanimously carried.
