Mr. M. G. Johnson and wife who reside on Shepherd ave. and adjoining residence property of Harry Abram, appeared before the City Tommission, complaining about the noise being made by geese ewned by the said Harry Abram, and asked that an ordinance be passed making it a violation of the law for a person to keep geese in an enclosure within three or four hundred feet of a private residence in the corporate limits of the City of Lufkin. After due consideration of the matter it was moved by Joe C. Denman and seconded by W. A. Behannon that City manager V.R. Smitham and Commissioner E.W. Leach be and are hereby directed to confer with the said marry Abram about said matter in order to see if he would not remove his geese. The motion carried unanimously.

"AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TAXING OF COSTS AGAINST EACH DEFENDANT IN CRIMINAL ACTIONS TRIED IN THE CORPORATION COURT TO BE COLLECTED OF THE DEFENDANT IN CASE OF HIS CONVICTION" was presented for passage and approval on second and final reading. After discussion of same, on motion made by Joe c. Denman and seconded by E. W. Leach, that said ordinance be placed on second reading and passed and approved thereon, the mayor put the question and requested all members who favored the passage of said ordinance on second reading to vote "Aye" and those opposed to vote "No"—The following members voted "Aye"— J.W.Hawkins, Joe c.Denman, A.M.Walker, W.A.Behannon and E.W.Leach. The following members voted "No"— None. Where upon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading.

Came on for consideration the question of installing street lights at the following places, to-wit: one at intersection of Grimes Street and Lake Street, one at intersection of Davis Street and Lake Street and one on South Second Street, formerly Abram Street. After discussing the matter it was voted that streets lights be installed at the places designated.
