MINUTES OF Regular MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD April 6th
1943 AT 7:30 PM.

On this the 6th day of April, A. D. 1943,
the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in
Regular session, in the regular meeting place in said
City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

C. C. Trevathan, Commissioner, Ward No. 1

B. F. Milligan, Commissioner, Ward No. 3

being present, and the following absent: _____,
constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Minutes of all meetings held during the month of March
were read and approved:

2. The returns of the City Election held this date were can-
vassed and an ordinance was introduced by Cary C. Trevathan
seconded by Jas. A. Abney and carried by all members voting
yea, declaring W. M. Glenn elected Mayor, Arthur Temple Jr.,
elected Commissioner of Ward No. 1 and B. F. Milligan elected
Commissioner of Ward No. 3.

3. The proposed ordinance regulating dogs running at large
within the City was read and Mr. Kelley recommended it's
adoption.

4. Motion was made by B. F. Milligan, seconded by Jas.
A. Abney that the ordinance be adopted as read and passed on
first reading.

Motion was carried by all members voting yea.

5. Cary C. Trevathan moved and R. E. Melvin seconded that the
ordinance be passed on second reading.

Motion carried by all
voting yea.

6. Motion was made by Jas. A. Abney and seconded by
B. F. Milligan that Cary C. Trevathan be paid \$70.00 for the
seven months he has been in the service of the U.S. Army and
for which he has not been paid salary as City Commissioner.

The motion carried by all members voting yea.

7. Written request signed by a number of residents in the 700
Block on Conn Avenue was presented asking that this street be
improved by oil treatment.

8. Similar requests were made by res-
idents and property owners for improvement of Hoskins Street
between Geneva and Everitt Streets and for East Lufkin Avenue
between Fourth Street and Shepherd Avenue.

9. They were all told
that estimates would be made by the City Manager and presented
to them showing the cost to the property owners and to the City
to provide the Oil Treatment so they would have an opportunity



to accept or reject the proposal.


- 10. Mr. Kelley requested advice as to the policy the City should adopt with reference to paying or not paying employees of the City for vacations earned in the event of their being called into the armed service of the Government.
- 11. Without formal action, he was instructed to approve such earned vacation time for payment.

Nothing further was presented for attention and the meeting was adjourned.
