MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE  
CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD  
April 5th, 1932.

Be it remembered that on this the 5th day of April, A.D. 1932,  
there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of  
the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with  
the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of all former meetings held in the month of March, 1932,  
read, and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

A. E. Greager appeared before the City Commission, this being the  
second time he so appeared, and demanded to know what the City would  
do regarding settlement for damages claimed due him as a result of  
the City's Main line sewer backing up into his residence, he at the same  
time being asked what he wanted the City to do to satisfy him, stated  
that he wished the residence raised eighteen (18) inches higher than  
its present level, that he wanted the lot cleaned off where sewer had  
overflowed same and the entire lot refilled to a depth of eighteen (18)  
inches. His proposition was not acceded to. The City requested that  
if sufficient time was given it, an effort would be made to remedy the  
situation in order to stop the overflow of the sewer all along the  
line, and would also make an effort to correct any damage, *George to the City of Lufkin* if any had  
been sustained, to the satisfaction of him, the said A.E. Graiger. This  
he, A.E. Graiger, did not agree to do. Hence the matter was passed without  
any definite thing being agreed upon.

The matter of providing funds for the use and benefit of the Com-  
munity Chest was discussed, after which it was moved by M. M. Jones, and  
seconded by C. A. Burke, that the City provide such funds in the sum of  
\$500.00 by executing a long time note, and that provision be made in the  
annual budget for payment of such note. The vote was called for and re-  
sult of same as follows: "AYES"- M.M. Jones and C.A. Burke- "NOES"- Wm.  
A. Foster, W. O. Greene, and W.A. Abney. The Mayor, therefore declared

the motion defeated.

J. T. Roach appeared before the City Commission and represented to it that heretofore a certain house had burned, same belonging to his sister, Mrs. Annie Gaston; that said house was insured and that the City through its City Attorney has notified the Insurance Company to withhold payment of the insurance money to the said Annie Gaston because the City desired to take steps to collect certain City Taxes due on said property by having such money, or so much thereof as needed, paid to the City in satisfaction of said taxes. He, the said J. T. Roach, stated that he desired the City to release the Insurance Company and allow the Insurance money to be paid direct to the beneficiary in the insurance policy, and that by so doing it would give him a chance to clear said property of certain indebtedness against it, and that he would then put said property up for a loan and pay all taxes due on said property. After hearing the above matter, it was moved by C. A. Burke and seconded by M. M. Jones that the relief asked for be granted. The motion carried unanimously.
