A Quorum being present, the following business was transacted.

The Commission convened in Special Session for the purpose of opening bids on One 750 G. P. M. Booster Pumper for the Lufkin Fire Department. The bids were opened by the City Manager and tabulated as follows:


Mack Motors Corporation-----\$16,196.00

Seagrave Corporation-----\$15,418.50

American-LaFrance-Foamite Corp.-----\$15,750.00

After hearing discussions by Representatives of the above Bidders, it was moved by Commission Stegall, and seconded by Commission Nerren that the City accept the Bid of the Seagrave Corporation at a Bid price of \$15,418.50 delivery to be made within a period of 90 to 100 working days. All voted "Aye".
