

The City Council of the City of Lufkin
Texas met in regular session on this
the 7th day of May 1918 with the
following named officers present
K. Morgan mayor presiding; W.D. Price
Chas. L. Bonner and T.A. Behannon
Aldermen, and R.P. Walker Secretary
Two of the Aldermen being absent and
as there is some very important business
to come before this Council meeting
it was moved and seconded and so ordered
that this Council stand adjourned till

Wednesday at 7.30 p.m., 1918 in order
to have a better attendance of the aldermen

Adjourned meeting of the city council
met on this the 8th day of May 1918
Moved seconded that the report of W.L. Sullivan
Sanitary inspector be and the same is hereby
approved

Moved and seconded that the Mayor have
drawn, to be enacted and passed by the
City Council, requiring the City Marshal
to collect street taxes subject to the
orders of the Street Commissioner

The Mayor made his appointments
naming the various positions and
committees for the present municipal
year and asked that his appointments
be confirmed as follows:

It was moved and seconded and so
ordered by the Council in open
session of the City Council that the
above and foregoing appointments
as made by mayor R Morgan be
and they are hereby confirmed by the
City Council of the city of Lufkin Texas

Moved and seconded and so ordered that
the City Engineer write the Texas Asphaltic
Company about repairing street pavements
under their contract and guarantee with
the City of Lufkin

Moved and seconded that a warrant or
Draft for \$ 50.00 be issued to B.W. Blalock
payable out of any funds that have money
available in them for one month work in
eradicating the mosquitos

Moved and seconded that the Sanitary
engineer, B.W. Blalock be paid \$ 25.00
per month for a period of seven months
for his services in eradicating the mosquitos

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The City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas met in regular session on this the 4th day of June 1918 with the following named officers present, K. Morgan, mayor presiding, W. D. Price, J. A. Behannon, S. H. Hawthorne, W. D. Newsom and Chas. L. Bonner aldermen and R. P. Walker secretary when the following orders were made by said council

Moved and seconded and so ordered that capias proffices issue in all cases where fines have been imposed and not paid

Reports of J. S. Cochran city marshal, W. L. Sullivan Sanitary inspector, E. A. Perkins water Commissioner and Edgar Brown pound master were read and approved. Moved & seconded that the question of the old city dumping ground, sold to Dr. R. B. Bledsoe be referred to S. H. Townsend city Atty. with instructions that he demand the purchase price of said land or dumping ground.

The resignation of Edgar Brown as pound master was accepted but he was retained as deputy city marshal

The appointment of J. G. Driver by the mayor, as city pound master and deputy city marshal is hereby confirmed by the City Council. It is ordered that C. C. Bass be paid \$25.00 out of the street & alley Labor fund for his services in exterminating mosquitos.

Moved & seconded that K. Morgan mayor pay for Bluestone out of the Water works Incidental fund

It was moved and seconded and so ordered that the council stand adjourned till 7:30 P.M. on the 6th day of June 1918
