6. Mr. Early reported that permission had been secured from W. P. B. to complete the Bathhouse at the new Swimming Pool.

7. A petition from several Angelina County farmers asking that out-of-County produce trucks not be permitted to sell produce in the City, was read but no official action was taken in the matter.

8. A brief discussion was held concerning parking of trucks and selling merchandise from them, on the court house square, was held,

but no official action taken.

There was no further business presented, so the meeting adjourned.
