The City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas met in Called Session on this the 16th day of Dec. 1918 with the following officers present; K. Morgan, mayor presiding, W. D. Newsom Chas. L. Bonner S. W. Hawthorne and W. D. Price Aldermen R. P. Walker Secretary, S. H. Townsend City Attorney and P. A. McCarthy, City Engineer when the following orders were made by the Council

Moved by Chas. L. Bonner and seconded by W. D. Newsom That the contract between the City of Lufkin Texas and A. G. Lesterfett to bore and develop a well be adopted as read and upon a unanimous vote of the Council it was so ordered and said contract is hereto attached marked Exhibit "A," and made a part of the minutes of this Council meeting

Moved by W. D. Newsom and seconded by W. D. Price That the mayor and Alderman Newsom be authorized and requested to locate and procure a dumping ground for the city of Lufkin

It is ordered that the mayor be and he is hereby authorized to appoint S. W. Hawthorne, W. D. Newsom and P. A. McCarthy to assist him, the said mayor, to prepare a "budget for the City of Lufkin to be present to the City Council for consideration at the regular Council meeting in January 1919.

There being no further business the Council adjourned
