"A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, CALLING AN ELECTION ON THE PROPOSITION OF THE ISSUANCE OF STREET IMPROVEMENT BONDS OF SAID CITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING STREET IMPROVEMENTS IN AND FOR SAID CITY, AND THE LEVYING OF A TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF."

On motion and second duly made and carried which is fully set out in the body of the Resolution whish is of record at another page of these minutes, the said Resolution was passed and approved on second and final reading.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.
