Jno. S. Redditt appeared before the City Commission and made and appeal for an increase in the allowance or donation to the Library fund to \$50.00 per month. Dr. T. W. Hancock appeared in behalf of a bill for professional services rendered to one Simon Kuykendall who was hit by policeman Finis Whisenant. Greene, which unanimously carried the said claim was not allowed.

A petition signed by colored citizens living on Lining Street asking that a water line be installed on said street was read to the City Commission. The same was duly considered. The City Manager recommended that same be built on condition that property owners on said Lining Street would put up certain money to cover cost or part of the cost of same.
