

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD APRIL
4th. 1922.

Be it remembered that on this the 4th. day of April A. D. 1922 there was begun and holden A regular meeting of the City Commission in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in the said city.

Present and presiding the Hon. G. A. Kelley, Mayor, S. R. Parker Commissioner Ward #1. E. E. Woods Commissioner Ward #2, W. B. Treadwell Commissioner Ward #4, C. N. Humason City Manager, C. H. Rice City Secretary Pro. Tem. and W. O. Seale City Attorney.

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Minutes of regular and call meetings for the month of March read, and by move and second duly made and carried were adopted.

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The attention of the City Commission being called to the resignation of Mr. T. L. Dunn as City Secretary, by move and being duly made and carried C. H. Rice was appointed City Secretary pro tem for the above meeting.

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F. M. Vernon representing the H. W. Campbells shows being present with contract made dureing the month of November 1921 wishing the City Commission to grant him an extension or A redating for same was discussed in detail, moved by Woods and seconded by Parker to have City Manager Humason go over contract with Mr. Vernon and after his investigation take what steps he saw fit for the best interest of the city.

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It was Moved by S. R. Parker and seconded by W. B. Treadwell to instruct the City Manager to take the matter up with The St. Louis Southwestern Ry. Co. with reference to the proposed street line connecting Dozier Ave. with Frank Ave. to ascertain as to whether the city can run said street without having to move the old East Texas Depo. Said motion carried unanimously.

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Moved by S. R. Parker Seconded by E. E. Woods to instruct the City Manager to notify the City Health Officer that on and after April the 30th. 1922 the office of City Health Officer will be discontinued. indefinitely.

Said motion carried unanimously.

Accounts due by the city to various parties, firms and corporations for supplies, labor etc. were presented for payment and it appearing that those ~~expenses~~ that had been properly audited and approved by the City Manager should be paid, by move and second duly made and carried, were ordered paid.

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City Manager C. N. Humason was instructed to cooperate with the two City Marshalls with reference to making Sanitary inspections of ~~the~~ the city and to file suit against any person, firm or corporation found violating the Sanitary Ordinance of the City of Lufkin, Texas.

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A communication from the Womens Auxiliary of the Chamber Of Commerce was read before the City Commission concerning the several unsanitary conditions which existed in our city after which said communication was unanimously indorsed by each one present.

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There being no futher business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried, adjournment was taken.
