the following business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Woodrow W. Scott.
2. The reading of the minutes of the regular meeting of February 19th, was postponed.
3. The Commission approved payment of estimate number two (2), Lufkin Construction Co. Inc.; revision of existing water pump station in the sum of \$18,097.55 for the month ending February 28, 1957.
4. The City Manager and City Attorney were designated to confer with Mr. John S. Redditt and others, relative to the amount of money to be borrowed for the construction of a swimming pool and tennis court at the old Jones Lake Park.
5. The Commission voted to request the State Highway Department to designate Raguet Street as a Business Route for State Highway No. 103. Also, it was recommended that City Manager confer with the State Highway Department relative to the widening of South First Street.
6. The following applications for zone changes were ordered published; Zeke Huffman, for change of zone on a tract of land on U. S. Highway 69, from "A" District to "G" District; upon the application of Dr. Groom Shepard to change the zone from "A" District to "E" District on a Lot at the intersection of Ellis and Franklin Streets.
7. There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
