


6. Bob Day of the ~~bonding~~ firm of Raucher-Pierce Company, discussed Sewer Revenue Bonds with the City and recommended, if the City decided to vote such bonds, that it vote the maximum amount, and sell them as needed.
7. The Commission approved the payment of the monthly statement of Freese, Nichols & Turner for the month of October, in the sum of \$1169.21.
8. A committee was appointed consisting of Lynn Metteauer, W.C. Royle, and L.C. Brittain to make a study of the property located at the intersection of Vann Street and Lufkin Avenue.
9. The City Manager was given permission to remove the rock pillars at the intersection of Feagin Drive and Pershing Avenue, such pillars being considered a traffic hazard.
10. The Commission voted to install traffic signals at the intersection of Angelina and Denman Streets.
11. The one-way ordinance, regulating traffic on certain streets in the City was passed on first reading.
12. Bills for the month of October were approved and ordered paid.
13. There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
