## MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD AUG. 13th. 1929.

Be it remembered that on this the 13th day of August, A.D. 1929, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit: Joe C. Denman, Mayor, C. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, W. D. Tiner, City Manager, J. B. Woiton, City Engineer, W. O. Seale, City Attorney and T.L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The purpose of the meeting was to hear protests against the paving of certain streets, contracted to Scott Shambaugh under contract No. 4 of the City of Lufkin, Texas, but it appearing that an error was made in the publication giving notice of such meeting, no hearing was had, but the following business was transacted:-

The question of paving mill street from its intersection with Chesnut and the Cotton Belt Railroad to the second gate of the Lufkin Ice Company, and also that part of Groesbeck connecting said Groesbeck across the Cotton Belt Railroad Companys track to Chesnut at its intersection with Mill Street, was thoroughly discussed, after which it was moved by R. C. Jordan and seconded by C. A. Burke, that same be designated for paving, and duly advertised for that purpose. The mtion carried unanimously.

The City engineer reported that the following Streets, to-wit:
(1) Second Street from its intersection with the North Line of Rhodes

Avenue, to its interesection with the South Line of Pole Avenue.

(2) Pole Avenue from its intersection with the East line of North First

Street, to its interesection with the East Line of North Third Street.

On motion made by C. A. Burke and seconded by W. A. Abney it was unanimously carried that the said streets be accepted as complete in compliance with paving contract.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried same adjourned.
