An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS FOR THE PRINCIPAL SUM OF SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND FIBE HUNDRED (\$722,500.00) DOLLARS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REFUNDING, CANCELLING AND IN LIEU OF A LIKE AMOUNT OF VALID AND SUBSISTING INDEBTEDNESS OF SAID CITY; PRESCRIBING THE FORM OF THE REFUNDING BONDS AND THE FORM OF INTEREST COUPONS; LEVYING A DIRECT CONTINUING ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAX ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE LIMITS OF SAID CITY TO PAY THE INTEREST ON SUCH REFUNDING BONDS AND TO CREATE A SINK-ING FUND FOR THE REDEMTION THEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF SUCH TAX; AND ENACTING PROVISIONS INCIDENT TWO NECESSARY TO THE SUBJECT AND PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE"

was introduced for passage and approval on second and final reading. Commissioner Louis Hicks made a motion that said ordinance be placed on second and final reading and that it be passed and approved on second and final reading. The motion was seconded by Commissioner J. E. Jay. The Mayor put the question and the following is the fecorded vote on the motion: "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins, W. O. Greene, Louis Hicks, J. B.
