

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD DEC. 5th,
1924.

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Be it remembered that on this the 5th day of December, A. D. 1924, there came on and was held a call meeting of the Honorable City Commission of the City of Lufkin, in the City Hall of said City, there being present and presiding the following officers: Sam H. Kerr, Mayor, C. F. Becker, A. M. Walker and W. A. Behannon, City Commissioners, C. N. Humason, City Manager, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The Mayor explained the object of the meeting was to discuss the question of location for sewer disposal plant, or septic tank; also to discuss what scheme for water supply should be accepted.

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A number of citizens, Mr. Meginson, Tom Coleman et als, were present to discuss the question of locating the septic tank on acreage now owned by the City in the southern part or just south of the City limits. These parties stated they were opposed to locating the sewer disposal plant on the 26 acres recently purchased by the city. After discussing the question, Fred McClendon, Dr. J. W. Hawkins, H. L. Thackwell, W. A. Behannon and Lee Burke, were appointed as a committee to locate a place suitable for disposal plant and to report to City Manager.

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City Manager, C. N. Humason, was ordered to see officials of the A. & N.

R. Ry Co. concerning raising the track of said railroad, which will be necessary if the present dam of the City reservoir is raised, and the selection of water project postponed until City Manager makes report of conference with A. & N.R. Ry officials.

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City Manager, C. N. Humason, reported the appointment of J. T. Maroney, as Judge of the Corporation Court of the City of Lufkin, to take effect January 1st, 1925, which said appointment was ratified by the City Commission on motion by A.M. Walker, seconded BY W.A. Behammon; all present voting "Aye".

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----- There being no further business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried, same adjourned.
