being absent, constituting a quorum, when the following business was transacted:


1. Meeting opened with prayer by BMcN.
2. Mayor stated special meeting was called for the purpose of discussing with representatives from the Area Council of Garden Clubs in the City of Lufkin the beautification of City Hall premises.

Mrs. C. B. Richardson, Mrs. John Winston, Mrs. Tom Melton, Mrs. Finis Gibbs and Mrs. Belvin Stewart were present. Mrs. Richardson, acting as spokesman for the group, stated that the Area Council of Garden Clubs would like to take on the project of beautification of City Hall premises and gave an outline on the procedure that should be followed. She stated that plans would have to be developed and then her group would follow through with the plans if approved by the City Commission.

The City Commission was in agreement with the request of the Area Council of Garden Clubs and motion was made by BMc^N that the Area Council of Garden Clubs be authorized to proceed and present a plan to the City Commission for this beautification and if approved the Area Council of Garden Clubs would give the necessary technical assistance in the project and the City of Lufkin would absorb the expense. Motion was seconded by WOR and a unanimous affirmative vote was recorded.


Mayor expressed appreciation to these ladies for their presence regarding the beautification of the City Hall premises.
