1. Meeting opened with prayer by Commissioner Byron McNeil.

Mayor stated special meeting was called for the purpose of reporting results of trip to Houston this date to meet with Southern Pacific Officials and representatives of Bernard Johnson Engineers, Inc. regarding widening of Angelina St. Mayor stated that City Commissioners Basil E. Atkinson, Jr., M.D., Gene H. Nerren, Dayle V. Smith and himself along with City Attorney and City Manager made trip to Houston. He stated for the information of City Commissioners Carl Liese and Byron McNeil that we could now proceed with advertising for bids on improvements to Angelina Street.  
Commissioner Byron McNeil made motion that authority be granted to advertise for bids covering improvements to Angelina Street to be opened at special meeting of City Commission scheduled to be held at 5:00 P.M., April 12, 1967.
