The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

the dity Commission and asked that the said dity Commission take over the payment of one-half the rent on the site for the C.C.C. Camp, which amount would be \$4.50 per month. The matter having been considered, it was moved by W. O. Greene, and seconded by W. A. Abney that the City pay the sum of \$4.50 per month which is one-half the monthly rental on the site now being used by the C.C.C. Camp, and that the time for paying such rent shall run from the date it was occupied for twleve months forward. The mayor put the question and the motion carried unanimously.

AN Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN OCCUPATION TAX ON THE OPERATION OF EVERY COUNOPERATED MACHINE OF WHATEVER KIND OR CHARACTER AND MARBLE TABLES AND MARBLE MACHINES. REQUIRING A LICENSE AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY" was presented for passage and approval on second reading.

W. O. Greene made a motion and W. A. Abney seconded same that said ordinance be placed on second and final feading and that it pass second and final reading. The mayor put the motion and the following is the recorded vote on same. "AYES"—W. A. Foster, W. O. Greene and W.A. Abney. "NOES"—None.— Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.
