

Adjourned meeting

The City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas met on this the 21st day of Nov. 1918 with the following named officers present K. Morgan mayor presiding

W. D. Price, W. D. Newson & Chas. L. Bonner aldermen and R. P. Walker, Secretary when the following orders were made by the council

Moved by Alderman Bonner and seconded by Alderman Price that W. L. Jones be appointed water Commissioner in and for the City of Lufkin Texas and it was so ordered, all the Aldermen voting, yea and it was further ordered that the said W. L. Jones be required to enter into bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars as such water Commissioner

It was ordered that City warrants No. 2733 and No. 2775 issued to O. C. Herron for the sums of \$42.50 and \$19.05 respectively payable out of the Street and Alley Labor fund of the City of Lufkin Texas be cancelled and that a City warrant for the sum of \$61.50, The amount of the above mentioned warrants, be issued to the said O. C. Herron payable out of the Paroc fund of the city of Lufkin

It was ordered that Alderman Chas. L. Bonner be and he is hereby authorized and requested appoint a Sanitary officer for the City of Lufkin Texas. No further business the council adjourned to meet again, Tuesday Nov. 26th 1918
