constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. October Bills, amounting to \$3,314.95 were presented for approval and on motion of Arthur Temple, Jr., second by Jas. A. Abney, all members voting yea, were approved for payment.
2. Motion was made by Jas. A. Abney, second by Arthur Temple, Jr. authorizing payment of a bonus amounting to 10% of one month's earnings to all employees of the City who have been employed for one month or longer prior to December 15th 1943, the bonus to be paid on December 23rd 1943.

3. The matter of/parking automobiles on First Street and on Lufkin Avenue in the down town section early in the morning and leaving the space for unloading of trucks until a specified time was discussed but was carried over until a later meeting in order to determine the best and most practical method of handling.
4. City Attorney Brazil reported the terms of lease requested by the Texas Forestry Association representative on proposed hangar to be built by the Association on the Air Port property and without formal action he was requested to discuss the matter with them and make recommendation at a later meeting.
5. Nothing further was presented for attention and the meeting was adjourned.
