

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
HELD ON OCTOBER 9, 1946 AT 4:00 P. M.

On this, the ninth day of October, A. D., 1946, the city Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in a called session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

being present, with D. M. Thrash, Commissioner Ward 2, being absent, thus constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted.

1. This meeting was called for the purpose of public hearing on Zone Changes with the following action being taken: Motion was made by E. A. Gibbs and seconded by L. C. Martin to change a portion of tract 32, Map 7 of the John L. Quinalty League from Zone B to Zone F, as applied for by Jack Nerren. The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea.

2. Motion was then made by L. C. Martin and seconded by E. A. Gibbs to change Lot 5 and $\frac{1}{2}$ of 6 of Block one of the Medford Addition from Zone A to Zone C as applied for by Helen Price LaPrelle. The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea.

3. Mr. Curtis Fenley appeared in the interest of resident property owners of part of the Clark Addition and protested a Zone change in that addition, as applied for by Mr. C. D. Acker. The matter was discussed at length and action deferred until a called meeting set for Thursday, October 17 at 3:00 P. M.

4. September bills in the amount of \$18,415.83 were reviewed and upon motion of L. C. Martin and seconded by E. A. Gibbs, were approved for payment.

5. Mr. Early presented a proposal from the Peavy & Shands Law Firm, agreeing to accept and bring to settlement all condemnation suits for Right-Of-Way for present Highway locations for \$250.00 (two hundred and fifty dollars) each. One half of the fee to be paid on each suit accepted and one half after it had been completed. After a brief discussion, it was moved by L. C. Martin and seconded by E. A. Gibbs to employ Peavy & Shands for the above named suits at (\$250.00) two hundred fifty dollars, each. The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea.

6. Subjects discussed with no formal action taken were: A. M. College Hanger at local Airport, Highway agreement on Railroad crossings and swimming pool bathhouse.

There was no further business presented, so the meeting adjourned.
