

Lufkin Texas April 30th 1918

The City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas met in called session on this the 30th day of April 1918 with the following named officers present; K. Morgan, Mayor presiding, S W Hawthorne Chas. L. Bowser, W. D. Newsom and W. D. Price Aldermen.

The object of the meeting, as explained by the Mayor, being to settle with Layne & Bowler for developing a well at the new city pond for the city and it was moved by S W Hawthorne that the city settle with the said Layne & Bowler provided the Mayor is satisfied that the well has been completed and developed in all respects in accordance with the original contract with the said Layne & Bowler to develop said well and the Mayor having made the statement that the well has been so completed it seconded by W. D. Newsom that the city pay off and settle with the said Layne & Bowler in full for boring and developing said well whereupon the Mayor proceeded to settle with the said Layne & Bowler and paid them off in full.

Moved and seconded and so ordered that the Mayor have a house built at the new city pond or pumping station in which to stow alum or other materials to be used in connection with the water system of the City of Lufkin, and also a house built around the new well at the city reservoir.

And said mayor is further authorized to have the roof on the pump house at the city pond repaired

Moved and seconded and so ordered that the mayor appoint Chas. L. Bonner and W. D. Newson to procure a ~~gasoline~~ engine to pump the new well with at the city reservoir or pumping station

There being no further business the council adjourned till the next regular meeting in May 1918
