constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:


1. Bills for the month of November were approved and ordered paid.
2. Kay Morris applied for permission to install a gasolene pump for Robert Denum. Permission was given.
3. The Council decided to purchase uniforms for regular police-
men and firemen.
4. Mr. J. B. Nabors of the Highway Department informed the Council
that appropriations had been set aside for paving a 53 foot street
through the city with an 18 inch curb and gutter on each side but that
the 60 foot right of way agreed by the city had not been approved by
the Federal Bureau who required 70 feet. No further action was taken.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it
was upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned.
