MINUTES OF CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD SEPTEMBER 10  
1941 AT 3:00 P. M.

On this the 10th day of September, A. D. 1941, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas convened in called session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

being present, and the following absent: W. A. GREEN, constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Mr. Fowler, Mr. Huff and Mr. Graves were present for the purpose of considering the second paving unit, especially the cost of rock production. Mr. Fowler gave an estimated cost of commercial rock at \$3.50, sand at \$2.40 and cement at \$2.63.

2. For Unit Number Two the property owners would pay approximately \$31,150.00. Mr. Melvin discussed the question of using iron ore gravel instead of rock but this was decided to be impractical. The matter was discussed and the engineers were requested to prepare estimates which might be accepted by W.P.A. in order that the City be allowed to continue mining the rock at the present quarry.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was, upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned.
