Minutes of former meetings read, and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

W. C. Blackwood, a citizen living on Jack Street appeared before the City Commission and complained that he was being charged to much for City taxes. After hearing his complaint and giving same due consideration, it was decided that no refund would be made on previous payments, but recommended that in future, for a time at least, that he render his property at a lower value than same has heretofore been rendered in order that it might be evened up as much as possible.

Discussion was had relative to setting up in the budget for the next year an amount to be distributed each month to the velunteer firemen. No final action was taken but left for further consideration at the time the matter of fixing the budget came up.

The question of appointing Harry Kerr City Fire Marshal was discussed, after which the City Manager was instructed to whate the State Fire Marshal's office to ascertain whether or not it would be agreeable with that office to make said Harry Kerr Fire Marshal, while he was also filling the office of Chief of Fire Department. Final action was deferred until such information was obstined from the State.
