The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to consider the passage of a RESOLUTION providing for the furnishing, free of cost to the State Highway Department, necessary right-of-way for the paving of Raguet Street from its intersection with Abney Avenue and its intersection with Ellis Avenue, and to do and perform any other duties that might properly come before it.

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A resolution entitled "RESOLUTION AND ORDER BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, AGREEING TO PROVIDE AND FURNISH, WITHOUT COST TO THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, ALL RIGHT-OF-WAY NECESSARY FOR THE PAVING OF REGUET STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH ABNEY AVENUE TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH ELLIS AVE² NUE"

was introduced for passage and approval. Commissioner W. O. Greene, Made a motion that said resolution be read to the City Commission and that it be passed and approved. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lewis Hicks. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion. "AYES" Kenneth Hoskins, W. O. Greene, Lewis Hicks, J. B. Perry and J. E. Jay. "NNOES" - None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and approved.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.
