bids on the proposed 24 inch water line from the City Pumping
Plant into the City.

2. H. H. Null Pipeline Contractors of Houston was awarded
the contract, this concern being the lowest and best bidder in
the sum of \$202,890.44. Other bids received were \$209,748.00
by Swilling & Boyd of Whitney, \$220,985.07 by Hardin Construction
Company of Houston, \$228,046.50 by Andrews-Parker, Inc. of Bryan,
\$234,670.00 Wilks, Dake & Steed of Tyler, and \$270,410.90 by
George Consolidated of Houston.

Commission the meeting adjourned.
