2. The Commission ordered a Special Election held on May 25, for the election of a Commissioner for Ward Number 1 to fill the unexpired term of Elwyn Gipson who resigned.

3. The Commission ordered drawn a contract between the City of Lufkin and Mr. R. B. Sherrill, Jr. who has been appointed City Manager for the City of Lufkin for a period of two years at a salary of \$9,600, and in addition thereto the City agreed to move him from Vernon, Texas, to Lufkin, Texas, and to provide him with an automobile in his work as City Manager.

4. The Commission voted to have Open House for the City Hall on the afternoons of June 19 and 20 from 2:00 to 5:00 P. M. respectively.
