MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS? HELD OCTOBER 4th, 1921.

Be it remembered that on this the 4th day of October, A.D. 1921, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City; Present and presiding the Hon. G. A. Kelley, Mayor, S. R. Parker, Commission of Ward No. 1 E. E. Woods, Commission of Ward No. 2, B. L. Zeagler, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 and W. B. Treadwell, Commission of Ward No. 4, T. L. Dunn, City Secretary and Temporary City Manager, W. O. Seale City Attorney, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

On Motion of Commission Zeagler and seconded by Commissioner Woods, all members to-wit* G. A. Kelley, Mayor, S. R. Parker, E. E. Woods, B. L. Zeagler and W. B. Treadwell, being present and voting Aye, it is ordered that Contract between the City of Lufkin, Texas, and Lumberman's and Traffice Association be executed by the proper City officials, whereby said contracotor, Lumberman's & Traffic Association agree to prosecute to settlement all claims the City has and may have in the future for overwharge in freight by railroad companies on material shipped to or by the said City of Lufkin, Texas, the consideration to be paid the said Lumberman's & Traffic association is one-half of amounts recovered.

On motion of Commissioner Woods and seconded by Commissioner Parker, all members to-wit: G. A. Kelley, S. R. Parker, E. E. Woods, B. L. Zeagler, and W. B. Treadwell being present and voting Aye, the City attorney is authorized and directed to proceed at once in the manner provided by law to collect amounts due by individuals and corporations or firms for the amount assessed against them, being one third of the cost of street paving in front or across property owned by them respectively.

On motion of Commissioner Zeagler and seconded by Commissioner Woods, all members to-wit: G. A. Kelley, S. R. Parker, E. E. Woods, B. L. Zeagler and W. B. Treadwell, being present and voting Aye, that City be and is authorized and directed to proceed in the manner provided by law for the collection of amounts charged against parties firms or corporations for installing Lead Water Lines and Sewer Line connections under pavement for the benefit of the parties so charged.

Upon recommendation from the Chamber of Commerce of the City of Luf-kin, Texas, the Mayor appointed O. J. Lang, C. N. Humason and B. L. Zeagler on a committee to co-operate with and assist a like committee from the chamber of commerce in bringing about the necessary things required by the Post Office department with a view of establishing Free Mail Delivery in the City of Lufkin, Texas.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried, adjournment was taken.

The above and foreging minutes of the City Commission read and approved on this the 1st day of November, A. D. 1921.
