1. The matter was taken up of permitting the Angelina  
County Hospital Board to use the Old Wilson Home property  
owned by the City on Denman Avenue for a Nurse's Home.

2. County Judge Rolston, County Auditor Brittain and Dr.  
L. H. Denman were present and the matter was discussed  
after which motion was made by R.E.Melvin, second by B.F.  
Milligan that the City would repair the doors and windows  
to the building and scrub the floors and let the County  
use it for Nurses Home at a rental of \$50.00 per month,  
also that water and sewer service would be furnished at  
no charge.
