MINUTES OF A CALL MERTING OF THE CITY COMMISSION HELD NOVEMBER 18th, 1924.

Be it remembered that on this the 18th day of November, A. D. 1924, there came on and was held a call meeting of the Honraoble City Commission of the City of Lufkin, in the City Hall of said City, there being presenta and presiding the following officers: Sam H. Kerr, Mayor, C. F. Becker, Commissioner of Ward No. 1 A. M. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, Kenneth Heskins, Commissioner of Ward No. 4 (Commissioner W.A. Behannon of Ward No. 3 being absent), and C. N. Humason, City Manager, W. O. Seale City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

The following styled ordinance was presented for passage and approval:

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PROPOSITION OF THE LANE-TEXAS COMPANY OF HOUSTON? TEXAS, FOR BORING AND COMPLETING A WATER WELL, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT AS PREPARED, A COPY OF WHICH IS HERETO ATTACHED, MARKED "EXHIBIT A" AND MADE A PART HEREOF".

Commissioner Kenneth Hoskins made a motion to finally pass and approve said ordinance; seconded by Commissioner A. M. Walker, and carried by the "AYES" following vote: Sam H. Kerr, C. F. Becker, A. M. Walker, Kenneth Hoskins. (W.A.Behannon, absent and not voting). "NO" None. Carried. The Mayor declared the ordinance finally passed.

AN Ordinance entitled CAN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE DEED TO J.T.SCURLOCK COVERING A SMALL PARCEL OF LAND ABANDONED BY THE CITY FOR STREET PURPOSES IN EXCHANGE FOR A LIKE PARCEL, was presented for passage and approval on second reading.

Commissioner C. F. Becker made a motion that the ordinance be placed on second reading; seconded by Commissioner Kenneth Hoskins and carried by the following vote: Sayes" Sam H. Kerr, C. F. Becker, A. M. Walker, and Kenneth Hokkins. (W.A. Behannon absent and not voting) "NO"- None- Carried. Ordinance placed on second reading.

Commissioner A. M. Walker moved that the ordinance pass second reading; second by Kenneth Hoskins and carried by the following vote: "AYES" Sam H. Kerr, C. F. Becker, A.M. Walker and Kenneth Hoskins. (W.A. Behannon, Absent and not voting) "No" None- Carried. Ordinance passed second reading. The Mayor, Sam H. Kerr, then declared the ordinance finally passed.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried, same adjourned.
