MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD APRIL 30th, A. D. 1929.


BE IT REMEMBERED that on this the 30th day of April A. D. 1929, there was begun and holden a meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the municipal office in said City, the following officers being present:

when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

THE PURPOSE of this meeting as stated by the Mayor being to pass on second and final reading an ordinance levying assessments for the payment of part of the cost of improving portions of certain streets, avenues and alleys in the City of Lufkin as described in the minutes of April 18th A. D. 1929, fixing a charge and lien against the owners of property and against their property abutting on said streets, avenues and alleys and against steam and street railways occupying the same; providing for the issuance of assignment certificates upon the completion and acceptance of said work or any unit thereof, and the manner of their collection, the said ordinance levying the assessments against the various property owners on the streets, avenues and alleys embraced in the city's program was read and on motion of Commissioner Abney, seconded by Commissioner Brazil, all voting yea, was passed on second and final reading.

The above and foregoing minutes read and approved on this the 7th day of May A. D. 1929.
