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It is ordered by the City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas that the contracts with the Lufkin Light and power company, the Lufkin Ice plant, and the Lufkin Foundry as presented by Judge E. J. Mantooth, acting as agent and attorney for said companies or corporations and approved and accepted by the City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas for the purpose of procuring money with which to assist in paying to have a well developed for the City of Lufkin Texas be and the same are hereby approved

It was moved by W. D. Price and seconded by S. W. Hawthorne all members of the Council present voting aye that there be created a city fund to be styled and known as a "Well fund," in which all money procured to bore a well shall be deposited and account and claims that may hereafter be allowed and approved by the City incident to boring a well shall be ordered paid out of the well fund

It was moved and seconded and ordered by the City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas that E. A. Perkins, water Commissioner and P. A. McCarthy, City Engineer go out to the old City pond tomorrow, March the 13th and see if they can devise some way of getting the water out of said old city pond into the new city pond.

45 Moved and seconded and so ordered that the mayor appoint and employ someone to audit the city books of the various city officers of the City of Tufkin Texas said audit to date from the last audit of said books upto the time said audit herein mention and ordered made may be completed.

There being no further business before the Council it moved and seconded and so ordered that the Council adjourn.
