MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD MARCH 19th, A. D. 1929.

On this day the City Commission met in called session at the City Hall in said City with the following officers present and presiding, towit: Joe C. Benman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1 and Mayor pro-tem, C. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, M. C. Spivey, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 and W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, V. R. Smitham, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney and T.L. (Mayor, J. W. Hawkins was absent)

Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The purpose of the meeting was to accept certain streets as being paved and ready for acceptance as provided by the contract with Scott Shambaugh, and to do and perform such other things and matters as may properly come before the body.

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It appearing that Frank Avenue from E. Line of N. Raguet St, to itstintersection with North Angelina Avenue and Moore Avenue from its intersection with west line of Herndon Street to its intersection with east line of Bledsoe Street have been completed according to contract for street paving, on motion duly made and carried same were accepted as appears from ordinance herein.

An ordinance to be known as the "GARBAGE ORDINANCE" was presented for passage and approval on first reading. M. C. Spivey, made a motion which was seconded by C. A. Burke that said ordinance be placed on first reading and that it pass first reading. The Mayor protem put the question and the following vote is here entered of record: "AYES"— Joe C. Benman, C. A. Burke, M. C. Spivey and W. A. Abney, NOES— None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the ordinance passed on first reading.

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The City Manager reported that C. C. Vinson had proposed to buy that portion of Lot No. 8 in Block No. 1 of the West End Addition which said property had been purchased from F. A. Larkins and wife by the City to provide right-of-way for Kelley Street pavement. It was moved by C. A. Burke and seconded by W. A. Abney that that

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portion of said Lot 8 block 1 of the West End Additon to the City of Lufkin, Texas, remaining after the City had taken such part as was required to give Kelley Street proper width, be sold to C. C. Vinson for the sum of \$363.50 cash, and he the said C.C. Vinson to assume the property owner's part of the cost of paving Kelley Street. Said motion carried unanimously.

City Manager V.R. Smitham stated that it was necessary to purchase a new chlorinator for the sewer department to be used in connection with the proper operation of the disposal plant. It was moved by C. A. Burke and seconded by W.A. Abney that such purhase be made. Motion carried unanimously.

City Manager V. R. Smitham stated that to properly take care of the garbage disposal it would be necessary to purchase a regular garbage truck. On motion duly made and carried steh purchase was

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ordered made.

City Manager also requested permission or authority to buy a new road grader. And it appearing that the old grader was practically worn out and that to properly maintain the dirst streets of the City it would be necessary to make such purchase it was moved by W. A. Abney and seconded by C. A. Burke, all voting yea, that the City Manager make the purchase of a grader as recommended.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried same adjourned.

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUPKIN HELD MARCH 19. A. D. 1929.

Be it remembered that on this the 19th day of March A. D. 1929, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Hall thereof with the following members present, to-wit: J. C. Denman, Commissioner Ward No. 1 and Mayor Pro Temp.; C. A. Burke, Commissioner Ward No.2; M. C. Spivey, Commissioner Ward No.3; W. A. Abney, Commissioner Ward No.4; V. R. Smitham, City Manager; T. L. Dunn City Secretary, and W. O. Seale, City Attorney, when among other matters the following praceedings were had, to-wit:

It appearing to the City Commission that that portions of two avenues, viz:

(a) Frank Avenue from its intersection with east line of North Raguet Street to its intersection with North Angelina Avenue;
(b) Moore Avenue from its intersection with west line of Herndon Street to its intersection with east line of Bledsce Street;
have been completed according to contract for street paving with Scott Shambaugh of Houston, Texas, of date Aug. 24th A. D. 1928, and the acceptance of said avenues have been recommended in writing by City Engineer and City Manager, Mr. V. R. Smitham; on motion M. C. Spivey, seconded by C. A. Burke, all voting yea, said avenues were accepted from Scott Shambaugh, paving contractor, and said improvement on said avenues are now received and accepted by the City.

The Mayor and City Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to issue improvement assessment certificates therefor in accordance with the assessments ordinance heretofore passed, a form of said assessment certificates has heretofore been approved for use in the present paving program, which is in all respects approved.
