

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF  
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY  
OF LUFKIN TEXAS HELD MARCH  
2ND? 1926.

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Be it remembered that on this the 2nd day of March, A. D. 1926, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City: Present and presiding the Hon. J. W. Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, E. W. Leach, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, C. N. Humason, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when, among other things, the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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Minutes of former meetings read, and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.--

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It appearing that it is necessary to hold the annual City Election the first Tuesday in April of each year, on motion made by W. A. Behannon and seconded by Joe C. Denman, all voting "Aye" an ordinance calling said election was passed, and is of record elsewhere in these minutes.

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The question of selecting auditing firm to do the annual auditing for the city, was gone into, and the following bids were read, to-wit: W. H. Rankin Auditing Co. \$285.00- T. B. Trotter Company, \$250.00. Moved by E. W. Leach and seconded by Joe C. Denman, that the contract be awarded to T. B. Trotter Company,; the motion carried unanimously.

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After discussing the question of opening a street from the Lufkin-Huntington Highway to Lufkin Avenue and Chesnut Street intersection was discussed after which the City Manager was instructed to have survey and map or plat of same made.

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Applications for service car license were made by the following: A. H. Goodson, Nacogdoches, Texas and Geo Lee, Lufkin, Texas. After haveing examined same on motion duly made and carried same were granted.

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City manager C. N. Humason presented his resignation as such officer, and after reading and discussing same on motion by A. M. Walker and seconded by E. W. Leach, same was accepted to become effective April 1st,

1926, or as soon thereafter as some one can be secured as his successor.  
The motion carried unanimously.

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Application for a permit was made by the Gulf Refining Company for a permit to install a new storage tank. After discussing the matter it was unanimously decided that such application be granted and same is hereby accordingly done.

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It becoming necessary that the City purchase 500 feet of new fire hose, on motion made by Joe C. Denman and seconded by A. M. Walker it was unanimously carried that same be purchased from the Lufkin Foundry and Machine Company, agents for the Quaker City Rubber Company.

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All bills and accounts due by the City to various parties, firms and corporations were presented for payment and it appearing that such of said bills as had been properly audited and approved by the City Manager should be paid, on motion duly made and carried same were allowed as appears on the minutes of accounts allowed.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, same adjourned.
