

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, HELD July 6th, 1923.

Be it remembered that on this the 6th day of July, A.D. 1923, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the City Hall in said City: Present and presiding the W. B. Treadwell, Mayor Pro Tem. (Sam H. Kerr, Mayor being absent) C. F. Becker, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, J. W. Lewis, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 and W. B. Treadwell, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, C. N. Humason, City Manager, T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, and W. O. Seale, City Attorney, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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Pursuant to notice heretofore given by publication in the Lufkin Daily News, the Commission met on this date for the purpose of adopting a budget for the City for the year beginning April 1st, 1923 and ending March 31st, 1924.-

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After due consideration of the question the following budget was unanimously adopted and ordered made a part of the minutes of this City Commission. The budget as originally prepared was adopted in full with the following changes, to-wit:-

Under the head of Water Department the salary of the Chief Engineer was changed from \$1,800.00 to \$2,025.00, and the item of running pump with motor was changed from \$2,000.00 to \$2,500.00. Under the head of Health and sanitation the item of Miscellaneous was added in the sum of \$500.00.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried, adjournment was taken.

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The above and foregoing minutes of the City Commission read and approved on this the 7th day of August, A.D. 1923.
