1943 AT 2:30 P.M.

constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Meeting was called to order by Mayor protem Jas. A.

Abney in the absence of Mayor Glenn and announced that  
it was for the purpose of a public hearing on the ap-  
plication for change of District under the Zoning Ordinance,  
as advertised.

2. There was no objection presented to the  
proposed change and on motion by R. E. Melvin, second by  
B. F. Milligan and duly carried the District was changed  
from "F" to "E" on the property from Cotton Belt to Wil-  
liams Street and from Keltys to Williams Street in North  
Lufkin.

3. The matter of forming an ordinance regulating dogs run-  
ning at large in the City was discussed and the City At-  
torney was requested to draft an ordinance for consideration.

4. The Ordinance regulating the operation of the Community  
Center Building in the City Park was introduced by B. F.  
Milligan, second by R. E. Melvin and passed ~~on~~ by all members  
voting yea. *on first  
Reading*

5. Copy of the ordinance is attached with these  
Minutes.

6. Nothing further was presented for attention and the meeting  
was recessed to March 25th at 10:00 AM.
