Be it remembered that on this the 2nd day of July, A.D. 1929, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City, with the following officers of the City Present and presiding: Joe C. Denman, Mayor, C. E. Brazil, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, C. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, F. E. Denman, City Secretary and W. O. Seale, City Attorney, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:--

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Minutes of former meetings read and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

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An Ordinance appointing J. B. Wotin City Engineer was introduced and passed, on motion made by R. C. Jordan and seconded by C. E. Brazil, with all members voting "Aye". See another page of these minutes for said ordinance.

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The Contractor, Mr. Scott Shambaugh, reported that he had completed certain streets in accordance with his paving contract with the City and asked that same be accepted, viz:--

(1) South Baguet Street from its intersection with the South Line of Jefferson Avenue to its intersection with the North Line of Zeagler Avenue.

(2) Homer Blv'd from its intersection with the south end of South Fourth Street to its intersection with north line of Denman Avenue.

(3) Jodie Avenue from the S.E. corner of Lot 7, block 1 of the Largent Addition eastwardly to the west line of Lot 11, Block 8 of the Denman Addition.

The City Engineer having recommended that same be accepted, on motion made by C. A. Burke seconded by C. E. Brazil same were accepted by a unanimous vote of the City Commission.

Denman, Mayor of the City of Lufkin, Texas, be and is hereby authorized and empowered to make an agreement or contract in the name and behalf of the City of Lufkin, Texas, with the Texas Power & Light Company, providing for a supply of electric power and ebergry to be used vy the City of Lufkin, Texas, in the operation of its pumping equipment and for incidental building and yard lighting.

On motion made by W.A.Abney seconded by C.E.Brazil, said ordinance passed on second and final reading by a unanimous vote of the City Commission.

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AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE MEMBERS
OF THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION IN AND FOR
THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR 1929.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the following named persons, all residents and property owners of the City of Lufkin, Texas, be and they are hereby appointed as members of the Board of Equalization in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the year A.D. 1929 - J. T. Roach, K. Morgan and A. Stroud.

SECTION 2. That such persons as such Board of Equalization shall meet at the time provided by the ordinance of the City of Lufkin, Texas, or as

soon thereafter as practicable, at such places as may be designated by them, and proceed to perform such duties as are enjoined upon them by law and the ordinances of said city. They shall continue their duties from day to day until the law applicable to their duties is fully complied with.

(1) South Raguet Street from its intersection with the South line of Jefferson Avenue to its intersection with the North line of Zeagler Avenue.


(2) Homer Blv'd from its intersection with the south end of ~~South end of~~ South Fourth Street to its intersection with north line of Denman Avenue.

have been completed according to contract for street paving with Scott Shambaugh of Houston, Texas, of date Aug. 24th A. D. 1928, and the acceptance of said avenues or streets have been recommended in writing by City Engineer, on motion C. A. Burke, seconded by W. A. Abney, all voting yea, said avenues or streets were accepted from Scott Shambaugh, paving contractor, and said improvement on said avenue or streets are now received and accepted by the City.

The Mayor and City Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to issue improvement assessment certificates therefor in accordance with the assessment ordinance heretofore passed, a form of said assessment certificate has heretofore been approved for use in the present paving program, which is in all respects approved.
