

CALL MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD MAY THE 11th. 1922.

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Be it remembered on this the 11th. day of May A. D. 1922 there was begun and holden A call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal office thereof; present and presiding the Hon. G. A. Kelly Mayor, S. R. Parker Commissioner Ward #1, E. E. Woods Commissioner Ward #2, B. L. Zeagler Commissioner Ward #3 and W. B. Treadwell Commissioner Ward #4, C. N. Humason City Manager, C. H. Rice City Secretary, W. O. Seale City Attorney and P. A. McCarthy City Engineer. when the following proceedings were had to wit:

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N. D. Shands and E. L. Kurth representing the Lufkin Independent School District being present in behalf of said school district presented their claim to the commission in regards to the water furnished said district as being exccssive, after some lengthly discussmon it was moved by Zeagler and seconded by Parker to have the City manager figure the actual cost of furnishing said district water from January the 1st. 1922 and present them with bill for payment and all water thereafter shall be furnished said district at approxi-matly cost. same ~~having~~ having been submitted by vote to the city comm-ission, same carried unanimously

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Moved by Parker Seconded by Treadwell to instruct City manager to enter into contract with some one for the construction of A new settling tank, same having been submitted by vote to the city commission same carried unanimously.

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Moved by ~~Woods~~ Seconded by Parker that the following budget for the year 1922-23 be adopted. same having been submitted by vote to the city commission, same carried unanimously.

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Moved by Parker Seconded by Treadwell that the City Manager be instr-ucted to purchase for the citys use one Ford Truck, same being submitted by vote to the City Commission same carried unanimously.

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Moved by Parker seconded by Woods to instruct City Manager to purchase building on Lufkin Avenue from Mrs. W. J. Townsend for the purpose of establishing general offices for the city, same being submitted by vote to the city commission, same carried unanimously.

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There being no futher business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried, adjournment was taken.
