

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, DECEMBER 9, 1940 AT
2:00 P. M.

The City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas convened in special session on December 9, 1940 at 2:00 p.m. in the regular meeting place with the following members thereof present, to-wit:

and the following absent: NONE, when the following business was had:

1. Mr. C. E. Brazil requested that the alley running behind his house between Raguet and Douglass Streets be closed (block 76). The Council instructed him that if he would secure the written permission of all property owners on the block upon a form prepared by the City Attorney, this permission would be granted.

2. Mr. C. B. Richardson and Mr. W. E. White appeared and requested that something be done about the rock crusher on Groesbeck Avenue. The Council stated that it was working on this matter at the present time and would do all it could.


3. Mr. Sam H. Kerr requested that the Council widen South Second Street between Lufkin Avenue and Shepherd Avenue. Mr. Stine was asked to secure the necessary information as to the cost of this project.

4. Mr. J. M. York of the State Highway Department showed the Commission a map with the various proposed locations of the loop through the town of Highway 59. The Council agreed to accompany Mr. York over the proposed route at 2:00 o'clock p.m. Tuesday.

5. Upon motion of Commissioner G. E. Barrington, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Melvin, the bills for the month of November were read, approved and ordered paid.

6. There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned.
