The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the question of allowing tax payers a percent off for payment of their delinquest city taxes or providing for the remission of penalties and interest on same. And further for the purpose of hearing a plea of S.W. Henderson, Jr. for a settlement of City Taxes on a basis less that the amount shown on the rolls, such property being known as the C.C.W. Sneed place on Moore Avenue. He, stating that the totla amount of the taxes due on the property was so much that in his opinion it would be fair to settle such amount for sum considerable less that is charged on the delinquesnt tax rolls of the City. He stating further that his mother had or was about to come in possession of the property by a foreclosure proceeding and that they did not think it fair and just for her to have to pay a lot of delinquest taxes on the property that ought to have been paid by the owner, Mr. C.C.W.Sneed. These matters were thoroughky discussed and considered after which it was the opinion of the mahority of the City Commissioners as expressed by them, that such consessions should not be made, and it was so ordered.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried it adjourned.
