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MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD
Sept. 30th, 1935.

Be it remembered that on this the 30th day of September, A.D. 1935,
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the
City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the fol-
lowing officers present and presiding, to-wit:-

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the question of allowing
tax payers a percent off for payment of their delinquent city taxes or
providing for the remission of penalties and interest on same. And fur-
ther for the purpose of hearing a plea of S.W. Henderson, Jr. for a set-
tlement of City Taxes on a basis less than the amount shown on the rolls,
such property being known as the C.C.W. Sneed place on Moore Avenue. He,
stating that the total amount of the taxes due on the property was so
much that in his opinion it would be fair to settle such amount for
sum considerable less than is charged on the delinquent tax rolls of
the City. He stating further that his mother had or was about to come
in possession of the property by a foreclosure proceeding and that they
did not think it fair and just for her to have to pay a lot of delin-
quent taxes on the property that ought to have been paid by the owner,
Mr. C.C.W. Sneed. These matters were thoroughly discussed and con-
sidered after which it was the opinion of the majority of the City Com-
missioners as expressed by them, that such concessions should not be
made, and it was so ordered.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on
motion duly made and carried it adjourned.
