T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had,

The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to pass on  
second reading an ordinance authorizing the borrowing of \$5,000.00  
from the First State Bank and Trust Company and \$2,500.00 from the  
Lufkin National Bank, and to do and perform any other business that

It was moved by C. A. Burke and seconded by W. O. Greene that  
an ordinance authorizing the borrowing of \$5,000.00 from the First  
State Bank and Trust Company and \$2,500.00 from the Lufkin National  
each of said notes to run 90 days and draw interest at 6%  
Bank, be passed on second reading. The mayor put the question same  
same carried by a unanimous vote.
