the following business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor, S. R. Parker, Jr.
2. The Mayor stated the purpose of the Called Meeting was to let the bids for traffic lights, controllers and signals as previously advertised. After studying all the different bids it was found Circle-bidding on W Supply Company/~~xxx~~ Eagle Signal Corporation,/^{equipment} was the lowest and best bidder for such equipment, and upon the recommendation of the City Manager, the contract for such traffic signal system was awarded to this concern for the low bid of \$8,287.75.
3. One-way traffic on certain streets was discussed and the matter was left open for further discussion.
4. There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
