MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF  
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD SEPT. 1st, 1925.

Be it remembered that on this the 1st day of September, A. D. 1925,  
there came on and was held a regular meeting of the Honorable City Com-  
mission of the City of Lufkin, in the City Hall of said City, there be-  
ing present and presiding the following officers: J. W. Hawkins, Mayor,  
Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker, Commissioner of  
Ward No. 2, W. A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, and E. W. Leach,  
Commissioner of Ward No. 4, C. M. Humason, City Manager, W. O. Seale,  
City Attorney, and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following pro-  
ceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of former meetings read, and by move and second duly made  
and carried, same were adopted.

-----oOo-----

The matter of passage of an ordinance consolidating the office of  
City Secretary and City Recorder was deferred to some future date.

Heretofore Mr. O. C. McNeil paid to the City the sum of \$12.70 for  
fine of one John Alexander who was at that time in jail, taking him  
to his place to pick cotton until the amount of said fine was paid;  
later officers from another County came and arrested the said John  
Alexander taking him away before all of said fine was worked out, and  
the said O. C. McNeil has filed a claim in the sum of \$7.70 being un-  
earned fine of the said Alexander. After duly considering the matter it  
was moved and seconded that the City return to the said McNeil the said  
sum of \$7.70. Motion carried and the City Secretary instructed to issue  
City Warrant in payment of same.

The matter of a settlement with W. L. Jones for lake rent up to  
and including the year 1925 was considered, after which it was moved  
by A. M. Walker and seconded by Joe C. Denman that settlement be made  
as per a statement submitted by the said Jones, which shows the said  
Jones owes the City the sum of \$8.00 up to January 1st, 1926. Said  
motion carried unanimously and settlement was made accordingly.

It appearing that the work of constructing the sewer disposal plant  
and extensions was not progressing properly on account of not having

a competent supervisor in charge of said work, it was moved by Commissioner E. W. Leach and seconded by Commissioner Joe C. Denman that the City Manager instruct the Engineer in charge to order all work~~ed~~ stopped until a competent supervisor is placed in charge of said work. The motion carried unanimously.

Accounts and bills were presented for payment and it appearing that such of said bills as had been properly audited and approved by the City Manager should be paid, by move and second duly made and carried accounts were allowed as shown on the Minutes of accounts allowed on pages 1 and 2 of Volume 1.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
