

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD
June 21st, 1933.

Be it remembered that on this the 21st day of June, A.D. 1933, there was begun and holden a call meeting in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal office in said City, with the following officers of the city present and presiding, to-wit:-

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The purpose of the meeting was to pass on second reading certain ordinances hereinafter described.

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An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING POLICEMEN AND PEACE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN TO MAKE ARRESTS, WITHOUT WARRANTS, OF PERSONS UNDER CIRCUMSTANCES PRESCRIBED IN ARTICLE 214 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE OF STATE OF TEXAS", was presented for passage and

approval on second and final reading. C. A. Burke made a motion that said ordinance be placed on second reading and that same pass second and final reading. W. A. Abney seconded the motion. The following is the recorded vote on same: "AYES"- Wm.A.Foster, W.O.Greene, C.A.Burke, D.A.Campbell and W.A. Abney. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading.

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An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT UNUSAL AND EXCESSIVE DEFAULT IN THE PAYMENT OF AD VALOREM AND POLL TAXES DUE AND OWING THE CITY OF LUFKIN HAS OCCURRED AND THAT AN EXTENSION OF TIME FOR THE PAYMENT OF SUCH DELINQUENT AD VALOREM AND POLL TAXES WILL PROMOTE AND ACCELERATE THE COLLECTION THEREOF, PROVIDING FOR REMISSION PENALTY AND INTEREST AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES ACCORDING TO TIME OF PAYMENT OF SUCH AD VALOREM AND POLL TAXES", was introduced for passage

and approval on second and final reading. W.A. Abney made a motion that said ordinance be placed on second reading and that it pass second and final reading. The motion was seconded by C.A. Burke. The following is the recorded vote on same. "AYES"- Wm. A. Foster, W.O.Greene, C.A. Burke, D.A. Campbell and W.A. Abney. "NOES"- None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading.

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An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO USE, MAINTAIN OR PERMIT THE USE OR MAINTENANCE OF ANY DRY CLOSET, PRIVY OR PIT TOILET WITHOUT FIRST HAVING PAID A LICENSE FEE AS PRESCRIBED TO THE CITY OF LURKIN; FIXING LICENSE FEE AND TIME OF PAYMENT AND PENALTY FOR DELINQUENT PAYMENTS; PROVIDING FOR SANITARY REGULATIONS, SCREENING, INSPECTING, REPAIRING, AND PROHIBITING INTERFERENCE; AND FIXING PENALTY", was introduced for passage on second and final reading. W.O. Greene, made a motion that said ordinance be placed on second reading and that it pass second and final reading. D.A. Campbell seconded the motion. The following is the recorded vote on same: "AYES"- Wm. A. Foster, W. O. Greene, C.A. Burke, D. A. Campbell and W.A. Abney/ "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance finally passed and approved on second and final reading.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried it adjourned.
