

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF LUFKIN, TEXAS? HELD MARCH
6th, 1923.

Be it remembers that on this the 6th day of March, A.D. 1923, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the city of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof: present and presiding the Hon. G. A. Kelley, Mayor, S. R. Parker, E. E. Woods, W. B. Treadwell, Commissioners being present, B.L. Zeagler, Commissioner being Absent, C.N. Humason, City Manager and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, also being present, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The question of whether or not R. B. Shearer, Contractor for the construction of the Municipal Building, should be required to execute a bond for the construction of same, was duly considered, after which it was moved by Commissioner Woods and seconded by Commissioner Treadwell, that the said R. B. Shearer, contractor aforesaid, be required to give bond, good and sufficient for the construction of said Municipal Building, same to be in accordance with the specifications as heretofore adopted, and same to be approved by the City Manager. Said Motion carried unanimously, and the Mayor declared the proposition adopted.

An Ordinance to prohibit the erection of any tent or other building within the city of Lufkin, Texas, within 600 feet of a private residence to be used for the purpose of carnival show or any place of amusement in connection with a carnival show, was presented for passage and approval, and after due deliberation and consideration of same, it was moved by Commissioner Treadwell and seconded by Commissioner E. E. Woods, that said ordinance be passed and approved. Same passed unanimously and the Mayor declared that said ordinance be and is hereby passed and approved and is to take effect according to its face and tenor.

Minutes of all former meeting held in the Month of February, read, and by move and second duly made and carried were adopted.

All bills and accounts due by the city to various parties, firms or corporations were presented for payment and it appearing that such of same as has been properly audited and allowed by the City Manager, should be paid, by move and second duly made and carried same were allowed.

An ordinance or resolution providing for the holding of the regular Municipal Election on the first Tuesday in April, 1923, was presented for passage and approval, and by move and second duly made and carried was adopted.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried adjournment was taken.
